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<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Establish mental health emergency response mechanism</li> <li>➤ Scale-up capacity-building for crisis management among frontliners</li> <li>➤ Increase substance use response services in North and South</li> <li>➤ Increase services for children with special needs in remote and rural areas</li> <li>➤ Develop shelters/supported housing for persons with mental disorders</li> <li>➤ Develop guidelines for evidence-based quality MHPSS services for children</li> <li>➤ Create consensus among actors on a model for technical support and supervision for mental health in organisations</li> <li>➤ Integrate the standardized M&amp;E tools developed in MHPSS programmes and ensure monitoring system</li> <li>➤ Harmonize compensation of mental professionals across organisations</li> <li>➤ Harmonize clinical files across organisations</li> <li>➤ Develop staff care policy for NGOs</li> <li>➤ Roll-out self-care training for frontliners</li> <li>➤ Develop criteria for triage of persons to be admitted for psychiatric admission</li> </ul>
