





## Global school-based student health survey results 2024 FACT SHEET

The 2024 Lebanon GSHS was a school-based survey of students in Grade 7 - Grade 12 (typically attended by students aged 13 – 17 years). A two-stage cluster sample design was used to produce data representative of all students in Grade 7 - Grade 12 across Lebanon. In the first stage, 62 schools were selected with probability proportional to enrolment size. At the second stage, classes were randomly selected and all the students in the selected classes were eligible to participate.

The Lebanon GSHS measured Alcohol Use; Dietary Behaviours; Drug Use; Hygiene; Mental Health; Physical Activity; Protective Factors; Tobacco Use; and Violence and Unintentional Injury. Students self-reported their responses to each question on a computer-scannable answer sheet.

The school response rate was 82.3%, the student response rate was 69.0%, and the overall response rate was 56.7%. A total of 3,745 students participated in the Lebanon GSHS. Because of the low overall response rate, the data is unweighted.
