








PHCC GEOGRAPHICAL DISTRIBUTION:


PROGRAMS:

A- NATIONAL EXPANDED PROGRAM ON IMMUNIZATION (EPI) EPI'S ACHIEVEMENTS




- National Immunization coverage > 92 %






Paps mear Campaign Reaching More than WOMEN





26,099 pregnant and lactating women were screened in 2018 for acute malnutrition at PHCC


